

This is a message from the Marion Board of Health

Due to weather conditions the Department of Public Health announced that the risk for Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) has increased in a large part of southeastern Massachusetts.

The Board of Health is asking that residents curtail evening activities from dusk to dawn. Outdoor events should be rescheduled for different times of the day.

Please note that the Board of Health will be closing playgrounds, ball fields and beaches at 6 pm.

If you need to go outside at any time of the day wear long sleeves, long pants and socks to keep mosquitoes away from your skin.
